


Our home is a converted Victorian Vicarage retaining some of the original features and charm. We provide a high standard of general nursing, residential care and respite care to give home carers a much needed break.

We also provide palliative care when residents and their families need specialist help and support.

We provide person centred care in a homely and welcoming environment. Our home is staffed by a team of professional registered nurses and dedicated carers who all have experience and training.

Our home is located in the pleasant suburb of Belmont within 3 miles of the beautiful Cathedral City of Durham and with excellent access to motorway, bus, rail and airport services.

The most precious thing we can give anyone is our time. All our staff are happy to sit, listen and talk to residents to ensure a home from home atmosphere is achieved.

A Unique Approach to First Class Care

Our person centred approach means that each resident is an individual treated with respect and dignity.



Each resident has a named Care Co-ordinator and an individual care plan. This will cover their personal and medical history, as well as a record of particular activities they enjoy and any cultural or religious aspects of their care.

Residents, and where appropriate their families, are involved as far as is practical in the decisions regarding their care. Emphasis on all aspects of care is the Manager's primary concern and, together with the experienced team of qualified staff, all adhere to rigorous standards with internal audits and checks.



We have an excellent working relationship with the partners from the local GP practice. We very much recognise the importance of personal, individual and resident focused care. To achieve this, good communication between all members of the care team, be they nurses, carers, relatives or doctors, is essential.

Our Facilities

Our home is well equipped to provide for the residents needs, and offers them light and comfortable surroundings whilst retaining a sense of bygone charm.



Belmont Grange Care Home is set in beautiful grounds that are enhanced by protected trees and local wildlife, all surrounded by an original stone wall. A sheltered discreet patio area provides privacy for our residents and relatives as they enjoy time in the garden.

Belmont Grange has a very friendly atmosphere for relatives to come into. Carers and staff are really focused on the resident welfare.

Relative

The front lounge and the 'Old Wing' are the original building and we have a modern sympathetic extension.

Throughout the home we have a choice of bright lounges, TV and quiet lounges and a conservatory overlooking the gardens, providing residents with a choice of environments in which to relax or meet friends and relatives.

All the bedrooms are tastefully decorated, where possible residents can personalise their room and choose the colour scheme, they can also bring in small items of furniture and other personal items.

We have on-site hairdressing facilities that are visited by an experienced hairdresser on a regular basis and other complementary therapies can be tailored to individual needs.

Our Services

We understand how important it is to have a range of quality services and facilities accessible to our residents at Belmont Grange Care Home.



Our services include:

Laundry

Belmont Grange has its own in-house laundry service which will launder all your garments free of charge. We do request that all clothing is clearly labelled with the residents name prior to being brought in. Any garment that requires dry cleaning or specialist cleaning will be sent offsite, which may incur a small service charge.

Hairdressing

Our Hairdresser visits twice weekly and offers a full range of services to both ladies and gentlemen. This takes place in the Home's very own Hairdressing Salon which is extremely popular and current prices are displayed on the notice board.

Clergy and Churches

Belmont Grange has strong links to the local churches and clergy visit the Home weekly to provide services.

Dentist

Our staff will help to arrange your dental appointments which also take place at the Home or at your usual dental practice.

Chiropody

A private chiropodist visits the Home on a monthly basis for any resident who may wish to use the service. All residents who access NHS chiropody will continue to do so as they also visit on a regular basis

Optician

At Belmont Grange we have opticians who visit the Home twice a year and visits in between these can be arranged if required.

WiFi

Here at Belmont Grange our residents have access to free unlimited usage of WiFi. You can also connect to the internet on the Home's laptop which is available on request.

Dining at Belmont Grange

Our Chef provides nutritionally balanced menus with fresh produce that is carefully prepared to ensure the best combination of nutrition and flavour.



All of our food is locally sourced, where possible, and all freshly prepared in Belmont Grange's kitchens by our Catering Team.

The menus are rotated every 4 weeks to ensure variety and you can place your food order from the daily menu. Your meal will then be delivered to you in either one of our dining areas or, if you choose, to you in your own room. Family or friends can also choose to dine with you if wish.

Any special dietary requirements are catered for.

Preferences and dislikes will all be discussed with you and our Chef when you first come into our Home, as we recognise that good nutrition is an essential part of a person's well-being.

Our Staff

Many of our staff have worked at Belmont Grange for years which means that we provide a level of skill and continuity not often found within the Care Home sector.

Socialising

We encourage residents to follow hobbies and interests; however there is no pressure and each person is treated as an individual.

Family and friends are welcome to visit at any time. Our residents particularly enjoy the local church coffee morning, in-house exercise classes, quizzes, movie afternoons and excursions to local places of interest.

Moving in Guide

Here at Belmont Grange we aim to help you at every stage of the process and to provide you with all the information that you may need to make the right decision for you.



Prior to being admitted to our Home, the Home Manager will come out to visit you to assess your needs, so that we can be sure that Belmont Grange can meet your care requirements.

You will also be encouraged to visit our Home to make sure that you are happy with your choice and you can of course visit it on more than one occasion if you wish.

Referral into care is usually dependant upon the means of payment, and if funded by your local authority then your Social Services Care Manager will undertake an Assessment of Need.

If it is felt that you need Nursing Care then you will be referred on to the relevant team for a Nursing Assessment.

If you are funding your care privately then it is your own decision as to how and when you would like to come into Belmont Grange.

It is very important that all people advising you on your care options are clear about the financial aspects of it. We recognise this can be stressful and worrying and would always encourage you to speak with our Home Manager who will help to clarify the process with you.



Personal Possessions



Belmont Grange is noted for its very cosy and homely environment.

We encourage you to bring items with you from home that will help you personalise your room and make you feel 'at home' such as things of sentimental value. There are television points in all rooms and you are welcome to bring your own TV from home.

Belmont Grange does not have 'visiting times' as we believe that this is your home. Therefore your family and friends can come and go whenever they wish.

If you have a pet that you would like to bring with you, this may be possible and will be discussed fully with the Care Manager beforehand.

Alternatively, we positively encourage family pets to come and visit as this brings great joy to the residents.

Categories of Care

Before moving into Belmont Grange you will need to have the type of care you require assessed.



This is to ensure that the Home can provide all the care and services you require to live here happily and successfully.

Here at Belmont Grange, we provide both Nursing and Residential care.

Nursing Care

Nursing care is provided by fully qualified Registered Nurses 24 hours a day and will be suitable for you if you require care with a medical condition.

We also provide a highly skilled palliative care service within the Home and have very strong links and working relationships with all local GP practices.

Residential Care

Residential care is suitable for you if you need some help and support with normal every day living activities, such as bathing and dressing, mobilisation, eating and drinking as well as medication support and activities. We support you to maintain as much independence as possible.


Respite Care

We offer Respite Care which may be suitable for you if you need a short break from your home after illness, an operation, or to give your normal caregivers a break.

This is normally from one week duration and over.
